RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Albert Agricultural Society #133 and show staff do not assume any responsibility for accidents or illness to horses, riders, spectators, equipment or personal belongings while attending the show.

- 2. No use of whips.
- 3. Entry fee is \$4.00 / class except Open Poles and Open Barrels will be \$10.00 / class. Entry forms are to be sent to Albert County Exhibition, 5895 King Street, Riverside-Albert, NB E4H 4B5.
- 4. There is a limit on entries this year. The first forty (40) horses will be accepted.
- 5. All exhibitors must show proof of insurance.
- 6. The judges decision is final.
- 7. A horse cannot be ridden by more than one rider in the same class.
- 8. All exhibitors must be properly dressed for the class they enter. A minimum of a short sleeve western shirt (no tank tops / muscle shirts) and proper western footwear is a must!
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in preparation of entry forms. No entry shall be complete until or unless said exhibitor, representative or parent if under 18 years of age has signed the entry form including all post entries.
- There are three age divisions for this show: small fry is 12 years and under as of January 1st, 2023; Junior 18 yrs and under as of January 1st, 2023; and Senior 19 yrs and over.
- 11. Birth certificates or sworn statements may be required for age classes.
- 12. There will be a 5 second penalty for knocked over obstacles. Ex. Poles or barrels.
- 13. Riders must show in same age category for show.
- 14. Stallions must be shown by someone 19 or older.
- 15. All exhibitors must pay gate fee and will be refunded gate fee with their ticket stub upon registering.
- 16. No profane language and no display of liquor in light horse barn by exhibitors. Keep stalls clean and tack hung up. Stalls must be stripped after the fair.
- 17. All Junior exhibitors 18 years and under must wear a riding helmet, for safety in all classes.
- 18. There will be no entry fees returned unless a vet certificate is presented no later than five days after the show. 75% will be refunded.
- 19. Box stalls cost \$20.00 and straight stalls cost \$15.00
- 20. Horses are to be on the grounds on Thursday before the class and cannot leave the grounds until 3 PM Sunday
- 21. Exhibitors that attempt the classes on their own and do not go off course will be placed above any exhibitors that are led through the pattern.

Money for five placings: 1st - \$7.00, 2nd - \$6.00, 3rd - \$5.00, 4th - \$4.00, 5th - \$3.00

Money for Open Classes: 1st - \$25.00, 2nd - \$20.00, 3rd - 15.00, 4th - \$10.00, 5th - \$5.00
